Task	Schedule
<b>Alley Cleaning (Pressure Washing)</b>	High needs alleys are cleaned monthly in the spring and summer.
<b>Cleaning Under 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> Ave Bridges</b> Homeless Encampments see <a href="#">purple section</a>	Probation Crew will remove trash/debris from under 4th and 5th Ave bridges as needed.
<b>Dumping</b>	Probation Crew will remove large items dumped in the right of way as needed.
<b>Free Wall Alley Trash Removal</b>	Probation Crew routinely checks the free wall alley for trash/debris.
<b>Garbage/Recycling Container Maintenance</b>	Regularly cleaned & repaired during the summer season. Will respond to maintenance calls as needed.
<b>Graffiti on Signage</b>	Public Works will remove graffiti or replace damaged street signs.
<b>Potholes</b>	Public Works will repair potholes. Repairs made same day when notified.
<b>Sidewalk Repair</b> Sidewalk Pressure Washing see <a href="#">red section</a>	Some sidewalks are being repaired by City crews downtown with a small amount of one-time funding.
<b>Street Light Globes</b> Contact: Mark Rentfrow (mrentfro@ci.olympia.wa.us)	Public Works cleans streetlight globes downtown where needed once per year. Contact Downtown Liaison for globe cleaning requests.
<b>Street Sweeping</b> Street Trees see <a href="#">purple section</a>	The City street sweeper operates on Mondays and Fridays between 4:00 AM and 12:00 PM.

Task	Schedule
<b>Curb Repainting</b>	Curbs are repainted (yellow & load zones) as needed. Downtown curbs were repainted in June/July 2015.

Task	Schedule
<b>Cigarette Butt Bins</b>	Clean Team empties butt bins once a week.
<b>Feces Removal</b>	Clean Team responds to feces calls.
<b>Graffiti on City-Owned Buildings</b> On Public Infrastructure see <a href="#">purple section</a>	Public Works responds to graffiti on City buildings.
<b>Graffiti on Storefronts</b> On Public Infrastructure see <a href="#">purple section</a>	Clean Team responds to storefront graffiti. Matching paint provided by the building/business owner.
<b>Leaf Removal</b>	Clean Team removes leaves from public right of way and clogged drains as needed.
<b>Litter/Garbage in City Right of Way</b>	Clean Team conducts a 2.5-hour trash run each day of operation. Focus is on the downtown core but is on-call to outlying areas.
<b>Pedestrian Recycling Containers</b>	Clean Team empties pedestrian recycling containers once a week.
<b>Pet Waste Bags</b>	Clean Team refills pet waste bins as needed.
<b>Sidewalk Pressure Washing</b> Sidewalk Repair see <a href="#">blue section</a>	Clean Team is conducting a pilot program. They will focus on two areas: 200-400 blocks of 4 <sup>th</sup> Ave E and blocks surrounding 5th & Capitol.

<b>Flower Baskets</b> Contact: Mark Rentfrow (mrentfro@ci.olympia.wa.us)	Probation Crew hangs, waters, removes, and maintains flower baskets.
<b>Graffiti on Public Infrastructure (train tunnel, bridges)</b> Contact: Amy Stull (astull@ci.olympia.wa.us)	Probation Crew responds to graffiti on request. Their schedule is busy so it may take a few working days to respond.
<b>Homeless Encampments</b> Contact: Chris Grabowski (cgrabows@ci.olympia.wa.us)	Code Enforcement takes lead on homeless camps. If a cleanup is needed, the probation crew responds.
<b>Street Trees</b> Contact: Michelle Bently (360.753.8301)	Addresses concerns related to right of way obstruction, damaged trees, and pruning.
